### UPCOMING RESURFACING WORK GIRTON

Cambridgeshire Highways will be carrying out resurfacing work on Cambridge Road, High Street and Oakington Road, Girton from the 25<sup>th</sup> August to 4<sup>th</sup> September. The work will be between the Wellbrook Way junction and the New Road junction. A drawing is attached overleaf highlighting the area of works.

To allow work to be completed safely and efficiently we will be closing the road to all traffic between the hours of 1900 and 0600 each night. There will be a signed diversion route in place for traffic to follow.

Access will be maintained for properties and businesses within the works area, however some delays may occur as you may be required to follow the diversion to enter the site at the other end, depending on where works are taking place. Traffic management operatives will be on site to assist you. The signed diversion routes are also shown overleaf.

Please note that due to the nature of our work there will be some noisier activities such as removing the existing surface prior to laying the new one. This is unfortunately unavoidable, however, we will endeavour to complete all such activities as early as possible to minimise disruption to residents.

As with all our resurfacing work, the timings and dates for schemes like this are weather dependent and can change at short notice.

Please rest assured that the work being undertaken has been properly planned and will proceed in line with current Public Health England, and Government guidelines regarding Covid-19.
