Cambridgeshire Libraries can now accept new referrals to the Revised Library@Home Service. This service is open to Cambridgeshire residents who are housebound, shielding or isolating due to age or health conditions under the current COVID-19 Government guidelines, and who rely heavily on reading books or audiobooks.
