Annual report on sustainable and affordable homes

The Greater Cambridge Shared Planning Service (Cambs City and SCDC) recently reported on the progress made during the past year on building sustainable and affordable new homes. This shows that the Councils remain on track to deliver the need for homes identified in their adopted Local Plans. 794 new affordable homes were completed in 2023/24, 472 of which were in South Cambridgeshire. Affordable housing is defined as social rented, affordable rented, and intermediate housing provided to eligible households whose needs are not met by the housing market. Also of note is the making of three new Neighbourhood Plans which show the Councils' ongoing commitment to local community development.

Grant funding: The National Lottery's Climate Action Fund

This is not a SCDC initiative but I think it's worth drawing your attention to the Climate Action Fund, which is underpinned by National Lottery funding. It is intended to support community projects that show that 'communities can address climate change while tackling the energy challenges through community-led climate action.'

Substantial sums are available (though not directly to parish councils) – between £500K and £1.5M for community and voluntary organisations and local partnerships. More information can be found at the link below <http://tinyurl.com/4j69fkp5>

Consultation on air quality strategy

Residents of Greater Cambridge are being invited to help shape a new Air Quality Strategy which seeks to improve air quality in the Cambridge and South Cambridgeshire area, to protect the health and wellbeing of residents. Cambridge City and SCDC are working together to develop the strategy which aims to meet stricter air quality targets that were set out by the World Health Organisation (WHO). There is no safe level of air pollution, which is why both councils are seeking to reduce levels of air pollution as much as possible.

The survey gives residents the opportunity to share their thoughts on the proposals and the action plan which will be used to develop the final version of the strategy. The consultation will close on Thursday 15 February and can be found here: <http://tinyurl.com/bdzkb2sc>

<p>County Council</p> <p>Responsibilities: Education, Transport, Highways, Heritage, Social care, Libraries, Trading standards, - Waste management, Maintaining their estate.</p> <p>Some of these services are shared between Peterborough City Council and Cambridgeshire County Council but any concerns should be directed to the county council.</p>
<p>District Council</p> <p>Responsibilities: Council tax payments and benefits, Household bin collections, Housing and housing benefits, Council leisure facilities, Environmental health, Residential planning.</p>
<p>Parish/ Town Council</p> <p>Responsibilities: Looking after community buildings, Open spaces, Allotments, Play Areas, Bus shelters.</p>
<p>Greater Cambridge Partnership (GCP)</p> <p>'The local delivery body for a City Deal with central Government worth up to £500 million over 15 years, to vital improvements in infrastructure (decarbonising transport), supporting and accelerating the creation of 44,000 new jobs, 33,500 new homes and 420 additional apprenticeships.'</p> <p>Partnership between Cambridge City Council, Cambridgeshire County Council, South Cambridgeshire District Council, University of Cambridge.</p>
<p>The Combined Authority, Cambridge and Peterborough, our elected Mayor</p> <p>'A combined authority (CA) is a legal body set up using national legislation that enables a group of two or more councils to collaborate and take collective decisions across council boundaries.'</p> <p>What our mayor does – Business support, skills, housing, transport, environment, international, digital connectivity, resilience, research, and strategy. New homes.</p>
<p>Police and Crime Commissioner, Cambridge and Peterborough</p>

To support and challenge the Chief Constable to provide effective and efficient policing services for the area.

Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Fire Authority

The Fire Authority is the governing body responsible for delivering a fire and rescue service to Cambridgeshire and Peterborough. It is made up of Cambridgeshire County Councillors and Peterborough City Councillors.
