We hope you have received the latest information leaflet from Oakington and Westwick Neighbours. It contains details about the Hardship Fund that has been set up and how you can either access it (call or text Ben on 07342 945373 or Jo on 07714760582 or email oak.west.hardship.fund@outlook.com ), or contribute to it (https://www.justgiving.com/crowdfunding/own-hardship-fund ). It also explains how you can protect yourself from Covid-related scams, in particular how to tell whether you have been genuinely contacted by NHS Test and Trace. According to the BBC, around £5 million pounds has been netted by fraudsters during the pandemic. Make sure you keep yourself safe, and do not give away any personal information without checking if something is genuine.

In the last Update, we said that the Olive Tree Cafe was open for take-away and it has just been announced that it is now open for customers wishing to eat-in. Conditions are in place to ensure it is Covid-safe, and breakfast, lunch and cake are on offer. Currently there is no need to book.
