County Councillor Report - Luis Navarro

Local Government Reorganisation

- Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government relied on PwC analysis.
- New analysis shows unitary reorganisation could cost £850m over 5 years with no long-term savings.

Adults & Health

- Cambridge Children's Hospital: Bouygues UK appointed as contractor; first specialist children's hospital in the East of England; construction within 18 months.
- Adult Social Care rated "Good" by CQC: praised for prevention, reablement, leadership, and staff wellbeing.
 - Improvements needed: direct payments uptake, equity and inclusion, unpaid carers support, transition to adult services.
- Integrated Care Boards (ICBs): must cut costs by 50%; redundancies expected; funding gaps create major challenges.
- **Healthwatch Summit**: 8 Oct 2025, focus on mental health access, free and open to all.

Children & Young People

- **Care leavers**: Ofsted notes improvements in support, education, employment opportunities, and Staying Put arrangements.
 - Areas needing work: supervision quality, pathway planning, suitable accommodation.
- **Foster Carers Recruitment**: council appealing for new foster carers (short-term, long-term, respite).

Communities, Social Mobility & Inclusion

- Dementia Friendly Communities: support groups and activities in Ely,
 Littleport, Soham.
- **Cambridgeshire Skills**: wide range of local courses (English, maths, horticulture, counselling, etc.) available.

Highways & Transport

- Roadworks enforcement: £483k fines issued to utility companies/developers in 2024–25.
- Exploring lane rental scheme to charge for highway occupation.
- Concerns over excessive signage: misleading closures in Little Downham/Pymoor being challenged.
- Welney Wetland Centre shuttle bus: free trial from Ely station (Sept–Nov 2025).
- **Aurora Highways System**: new asset management system launches 22 Sept; promises better tracking, updates, and efficiency.
- Roadworks programme available online.

- Proposals for Cambridge 25. A high-quality employment park with nature at the heart of the design approach.
