Dear Parish Councillors

Re: Youth Work Services from April 2025

Firstly, a reminder that our AGM is on 28 October, and we would welcome councillors to attend in person (including coffee and cakes) or via Zoom. Please do get in touch as soon as possible if you haven't already.

We have had an interesting year which has included difficulties in getting drivers for our youth buses and then the buses needing to be retired from use. However, we were thrilled to receive a National Lottery Community Fund grant over the summer to replace the buses. The replacement process is now underway, and we expect the new youth buses to arrive in the new year.

Our building-based youth work has been able to continue in the meantime and a number of youth bus sessions have been able to temporarily relocate using our youth van with its bespoke equipment.

Despite all of this, we have continued to maintain high quality youth work and our survey of young people in May showing that:

- 100% said that they enjoyed our youth clubs/buses
- 94% attend regularly
- 94% said our youth workers were easy to talk to
- 77% said attending had helped to improve their mental health and wellbeing

To give you ample time to plan your budgets for next year, the trustees have decided to limit our fee increase to 5%, effective April 2025.

Starting 1 April 2025, the new fee for the services we provide to Oakington will be £296.

I encourage you to reflect on the needs of your young people and the importance of our services to them. Please let me know by 15 January 2025 how you would like to proceed from April 2025.
